The Dayton Elementary PTO is raffling off a brand new 2016 Yamaha Kodiak to raise funds for school improvements.

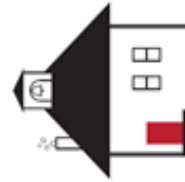

About Dayton School

- Dayton Elementary School operates as a K-6 public school located on the West Shores of Flathead Lake.
- Serving Dayton, Proctor and Rollins, Dayton School is believed to be Montana's oldest continuously operating school.
- Established as a 2-room school house in 1910, the school underwent an extensive expansion in 2005, adding four classrooms and a lunchroom.
- Since then, enrollment has increased from 25 students to 55 students in 2016.

Proposed Improvements

- Gym/Multi-Purpose Room
 - Larger lunchroom/Full Kitchen
 - Indoor space for students
 - Community Event Center
 - Adult Fitness Classes
 - Adult Education
- Additional classrooms due to increased enrollment
- Upgraded safety features to ensure student safety in the event of an emergency
- Repair/replacement of water, plumbing and septic issues due to increased enrollment
- Library/Media Center
 - Computer Lab – open for supervised public use
 - Continuing Education Classes

Phase One: Architect

Funds raised from our 4-wheeler raffle will be used to hire an architect to analyze the current facilities, solicit information from parents and community members and develop a plan for expansion.

Phase Two: Fundraising

Once a blueprint of the improvements is completed, the School Board will be able to solicit bids from local contractors and the PTO can apply for grants to minimize the financial impact to taxpayers.

About the Dayton PTO

The Dayton PTO is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose purpose is to support the education of the students at Dayton Elementary. All donations are tax deductible and are welcomed.

Why We Need To Expand

- Due to a 200 % increase in enrollment, Dayton School has outgrown their current facilities. School exceeded its anticipated growth for the past 10 years and faces a shortage of space and infrastructure deficiencies.
- The school does not have a gym or large room sufficient to hold the entire school or their families. PE is currently held outside, weather permitting.



- The library is located in the school foyer, while art classes are held in the cafeteria, which also serves as the location of the After School Program.
- The highly anticipated Christmas program can no longer be held at the Dayton School. In order to accommodate the larger student population and their families this year, the school rented the Flathead Lake United Methodist Church Camp, located 7 miles away from school.
