

**Contact with Students**

Students are entrusted to the schools for educational purposes. Although educational purposes encompass a broad range of experiences, school officials must not assume license to allow unapproved contact with students by persons who are not employed by the District for educational purposes. Teachers may arrange guest speakers on appropriate topics relative to the curriculum. The Principal may approve school assemblies on specific educational topics of interest and relevance to the school program. Other types of contact by non-school personnel will normally not be permitted. Outside organizations desiring to use the captive audience in a school for information, sales material, or special interest curricula will not be allowed access to the schools.

**Distribution of Fund Drive Literature Through Students**

It is the policy of this District to refrain from having the students, as student body members, used for collection or dissemination purposes.

Exceptions to this policy will be considered when recognized or student or school-affiliated organizations of the District request permission to participate in such activity.

**Use of School Property for Posting Notices**

Individuals and organizations are prohibited from posting or causing to be posted on or in any District property any information that:

- 1) has not been approved by the Principal;
- 2) fails to identify the sponsoring agency; and/or,
- 3) exceeds dimensions of 11" x 17".
